Specific Health Care Guidance

FREE

For those at high risk of lifestyle-related diseases, a "specific health guidance" will be provided after completing the checkup on the same day. You can receive advice from experts in a 30-minute consultation. Those who are eligible should definitely use this service.

Aggravation Prevention Program

FREE

For those with high blood glucose or high blood pressure, we will provide health consultation and recommendations to medical institutions through visits, by telephone, by letter, etc. Program information will be sent to eligible persons separately. We encourage you to use the service.

For those who undergo health checkups at workplace, etc.

If you do not opt to undergo a National Health Insurance health checkup because you had a health checkup or a general medical examination at your workplace, etc., please provide us with your "health checkup results". First, please contact our Health Checkup Subsection (03-5662-0623).

*If you submit your results, you will get a free "Guide to Using Health Checkup Results."

For those who have changed their health insurance

National Health Insurance health checkups are for those who are enrolled in the Edogawa City National Health Insurance program. Persons who are not eligible at the time of medical examination, for example if your health insurance has changed, please contact the insurance provider you are enrolled with.

Other physical examinations

FREE

Checkups marked with a★ can be taken at the same time as a National Health Insurance health checkup at the Edogawa Medical Association Examination Center. If interested, please inquire when making an appointment. *Eligible age is your age as of March 31, 2026.

Type	Eligibility and Details
Cervical cancer	Women aged 20 and above Those who have not received an examination within the last year Visual examination, cytological diagnosis, pelvic examination
★Breast cancer	Women aged 40 to 64 (those who have not received a mammography within the last year) Ultrasound or mammography
★Stomach cancer	Persons aged 30 to 49 Stomach X-ray Persons aged 50 and above Stomach X-ray or endoscopy (those who have not received an endoscopic examination within the last year) An endoscopy cannot be performed at the same time as the National Health Insurance Health Checkup. In addition, endoscopic examination may not be available as requested due to the limited number of slots available in a day.
Colon cancer	Persons aged 40 and above Fecal occult blood test (stool examination)
★Lung cancer	Persons aged 40 and above Chest X-ray, sputum cytology test
★Prostate cancer	Men aged 60 and above Blood test
★Osteoporosis	Women aged 40, 45, 50, 55 and 60 Ultrasound
★Hepatitis virus	Persons who have not taken the examination in the past Blood test

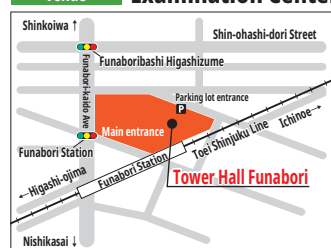

Guide to the National Health Insurance health checkups

Eligible persons

Who are enrolled in the Edogawa City National Health Insurance Program

Persons aged 40 to 64

(Born between April 1, 1961 and March 31, 1986)

*Not available to those who are a hospital inpatient, an expectant or nursing mother, a resident at a nursing home, or enrolled in other health insurance programs such as Social Insurance.

Checkup period

April 1, 2025 (Tue) to March 31, 2026 (Tue)

- Medical examinations are also available at designated medical institutions within the city only from August to November 8, 2025. A special examination ticket is required for the examination. If you wish to receive one, please contact the Health Checkup Subsection (03-5662-0623) after late July. The examination ticket for medical institutions will be mailed to you.
- Checkup period, etc. may change.
- Those who have not undergone examination during the checkup period may receive further guidance via postcards, etc.

Fee

National Health Insurance health checkups are free

The checkup is free of charge. It would cost about 9,000 yen if you arranged it privately. However, if any follow-up examinations are needed, these will be charged (insured examination and treatment) to you personally.

For outpatients

Outpatients are also eligible to have a National Health Insurance health checkup. Please ask your doctor about whether you need to have a checkup, and have one if at all possible.

[Notes] 1. In addition to informing checkup recipients of the results, etc. of their National Health Insurance health checkup, the results will also be kept by the insurance providers, etc. so that the results may be used for health guidance, future health measures, National Health Insurance services, etc. as necessary. Please understand this before you have a health checkup. 2. The data files for the checkup results may be inspected by the settlement agency. They will also be anonymized and partially submitted to the government as a report on the results of running the checkup program. Please understand this before you have a health checkup. 3. Illegal use of this ticket may result in imprisonment for fraud under the Penal Code. 4. Please contact the Health Checkup Subsection immediately if you are no longer qualified to be insured or if anything stated in your documents has changed. 5. If follow-up examinations are required based on the test results, costs will be covered by insurance. (Fees will apply.) 6. Depending on the circumstances, we also provide health checkups through home visits. Please contact the Health Checkup Subsection for details. 7. Those who have undergone a medical checkup this year may receive a notification of next year's national health checkup via text message to their registered contact (limited to smart phones). Blood test items

- Lipids (neutral fat, HDL cholesterol, and LDL cholesterol)
- Liver function (AST, ALT, and γ-GT)
- Kidney function (serum creatinine)
- Blood glucose ● HbA1c ● Uric acid
- Blood cells (white blood cells, red blood cells, hemoglobin, and hematocrit)

The mark on the right is the voice code (Uni-Voice). Information regarding the National Health Insurance Health checkup is available by audio for the visually impaired.
